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1 ColorNet® Pro Layaway.

This function provides the possibility to weigh a higher amount of a combination of material (formulas and ancillaries, non-activated and / or activated) to be stored and used at a later time.

When the material is finally used it can go over the scale to add missing ingredients, or be allocated to a job card ("Bulk mixing" / "Job Card Allocation"), if it is already ready-for-use.

Install ColorNet® Pro including stock management.

1.1 Create Layaway material.

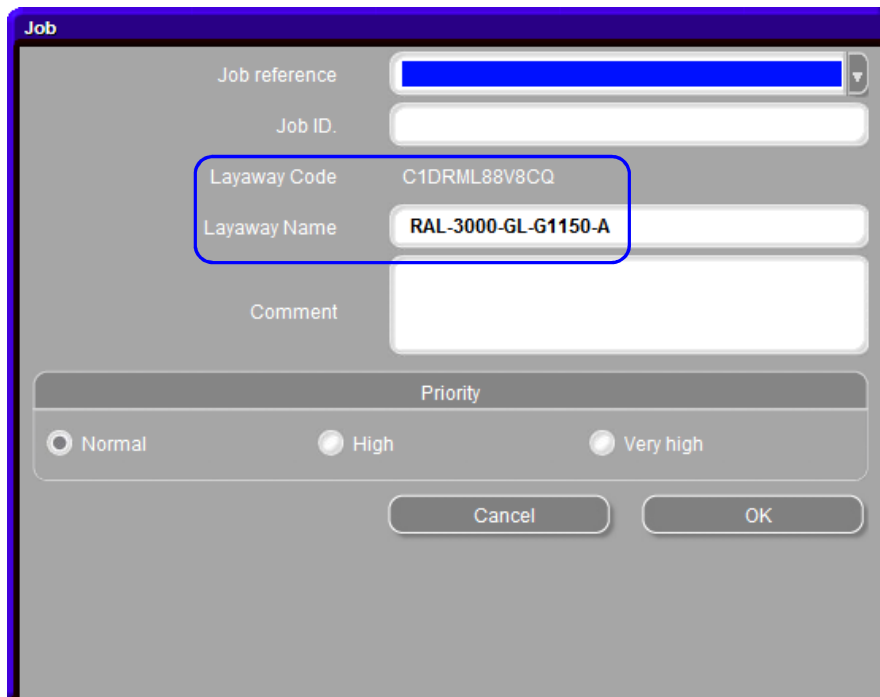
Select a formula or ancillary combination (without or with RFU ingredients).

Press the "Create Layaway" button on the formula screen

1.2 Layaway Code.

This code is created by the system and is converted into a bar code, which is printed on the respective label and by which the material can be found back.

Layaway Name

This info is predefined by the system; it can be extended by the user or completely replaced.

Weigh the job.

If your label printer settings are on "Ask user", you will be prompted.

Scroll down; the last label in the list is the Layaway label.

1.3 Use Layaway.

There are three possibilities to find and use an existing Layaway:

1.3.1 Use Layaway from list.

On the Search menu, press the button "Use Layaway from list".

Select the Layaway you want to use, either directly with the mouse or by typing or scanning the code from the label into the search files.

Double click the line or press "Use selected Layaway".

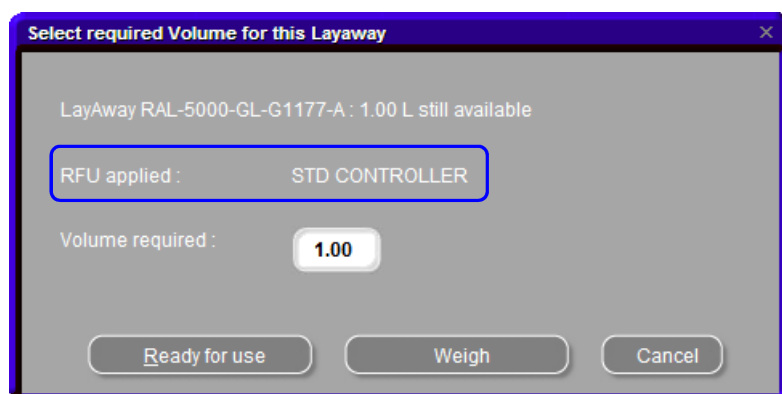

The available volume is displayed, you can change this to any (smaller) amount you need in the field "Volume required".

In case you selected a Layaway where RFU can still be performed, you can do so by pressing the resp. button.

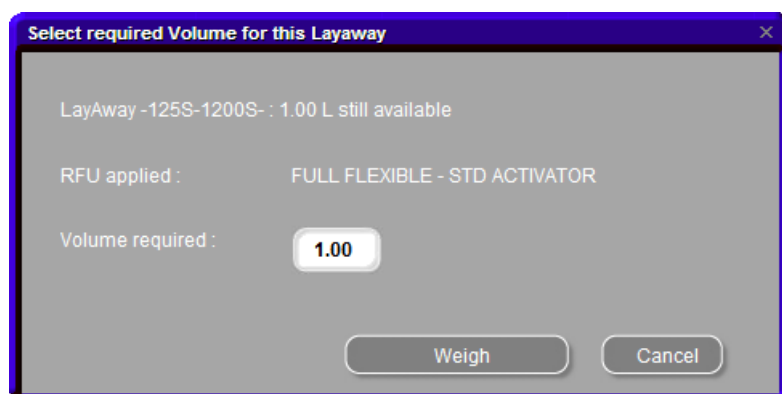

After having selected the requested material, RFU and volume, press “Weigh”.

If the material sent to scale contains more than one ingredient, the job goes to scale in the usual way (job dialogue, scale, labels).

1.3.2 Job Card Allocation / Bulk Mixing.

If the material sent to scale contains only one ingredient, you will have the possibility to use the material as “Bulk Mix”, meaning, you can allocate the material to a job card (= job reference) without actually weighing it:

1.3.3 Selecting a formula.

When selecting material combination from scratch, for which a Layaway exists, the system will find it and offer it for use. You have the same option as if using the material from the Layaway list (weigh or perform RFU). Or decline the offer.

1.4 Layaways in reports.

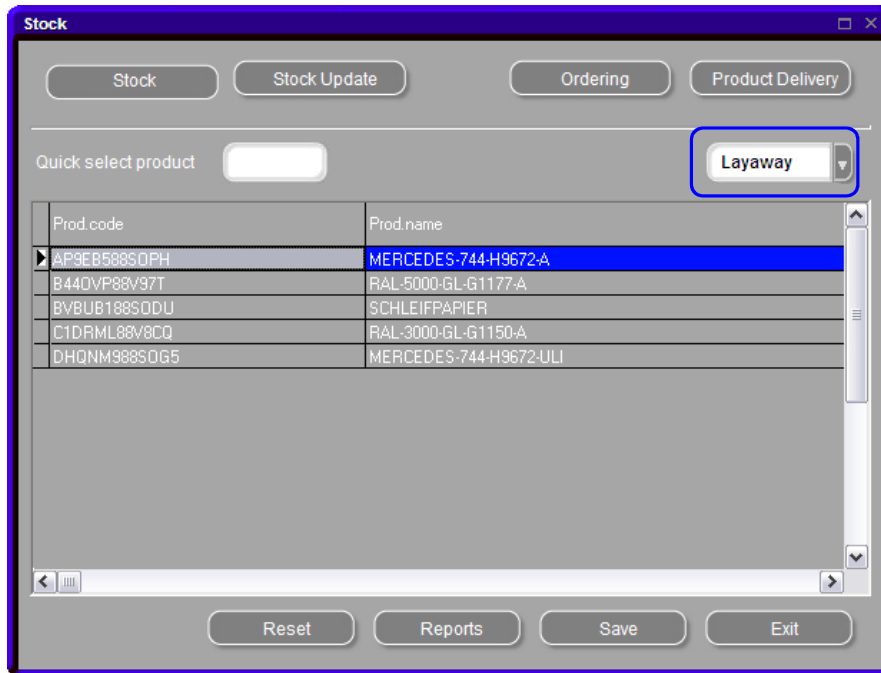
Reports 1. – 5. can be filtered by “Layaway”.

There is an extra report “Layaway Report”. Here you can filter by Layaway Code:

1.1 Layaway in stock management.

The Layaway function can be used without actually working with (maintaining) stock, but stock management needs to be installed.

There is an extra view for Layaway material and a report on Layaway is available:



1.5 Deleting Layaway material.

Go to Tools – Use Layaway from list, select one item, press “Delete Layaway”. You will be prompted for the reason for deletion:
